


Boice Family Park

The Blue trail exists in the path of the old Ballston Terminal Railroad which was an electric trolley that brought raw materials and workers to mill sites powered by the Kayaderosseras Creek. One of these historic paper mills, named the Pioneer Paper Mill was located along the creek in the area that is now Boice Family Park and is marked on this map with a star.
